



# SURVEILLANCE AND EXPOSURE PLAN

## SURVEILLANCE TESTING

Surveillance testing will be implemented based on the local disease trends. If epidemiological data indicates concern from increasing community transmission, Pasadena Christian School will follow instruction from the Pasadena Public Health Department to test staff in order to detect potential cases as lab testing capacity allows.

Three days prior to resuming in-person learning, PCS will make available on-campus testing for staff and faculty through the partnership with PathMD Lab. Individuals will have the option to test on campus or use their own health care provider for testing. If additional resources are needed, the school will provide testing information and a guide to labs by directing employees and parents to <https://www.cityofpasadena.net/public-health/covid-19-testing-info>.

Every two months after opening for in-person learning, PCS will provide on-campus testing for staff and faculty. The school will only have access to the results from employees who have signed a HIPAA form with PathMD Lab. Results will be obtained through PathMD's secure reporting portal. In the event an employee tests positive, they will be contacted by the PCS COVID-19 Compliance Officer who will assist with the protocol in the PCS Re-Opening Plan.

## EXPOSURE TESTING

Exposure testing will occur when an employee or student comes into close contact (as defined by the CDC), with a confirmed or suspected case. As in the procedure for surveillance testing, individuals will be directed to use the services of PathMD Lab or their own health care provider to be tested.

In the event of a laboratory confirmed COVID-19 case, the PCS Task Force will inform the Pasadena Public Health Department within one day in order for them to contact the employee (or parents) directly in to obtain additional information. The privacy of any individual testing positive will be maintained in accordance with FERPA requirements.

## MEDICAL PARTNERSHIPS

Pasadena Christian School is contracted with PathMD Lab for testing services.

Our medical consultant is Dr. Michael Neely, Chief of Pediatric Infectious Diseases at CHLA
