



ADDITIONAL MEASURES FOR CAMPUS CLEANING

DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

Upon opening for in-person learning, PCS will have a cleaning staff that will canvas the campus throughout the day. The objective will be to clean all high-touch areas on a frequent basis with EPA List N products. Area of special attention are all door knobs, railings, bathroom surfaces, play structure poles, and any other areas where children are touching.

In addition to the cleaning staff, teachers will have dedicated hand-washing times where children wash their hands a minimum of 20 seconds. Helpful assistance, such as singing "happy birthday" twice, will be incorporated.

The library will quarantine recently checked out books for one to three days before returning the book to circulation. PE and playground equipment will be cleaned after each use.

AFTER SCHOOL HOURS

Daily cleaning of the complete campus will be administered by an independent professional cleaning company. Professional cleaning staff will go into every classroom and school building to perform a thorough cleaning with EPA List N products. Cleaning methods will include, but not limited to, spraying play structures, deep vacuuming carpet/rugs, cleaning hard floor surfaces with a no-dip method, wiping high-touch areas with color coded micro-fiber cloths, cleaning of outdoor poles, and wiping of all student desks, student desk shields and chairs.

Weekly, the company will clean air vents, floorboards, high-reach areas that collect dust and any other areas that need weekly attention that is not covered under daily cleaning.

Prior to the return on in-person learning, the company will thoroughly clean the entire campus to establish a base-line of cleanliness to start the school.

KEEPING PPE CLEAN

School staff will not reuse disposable surgical masks and will launder cloth masks before reusing. Face shields will be disinfected daily and replaced as necessary.
